

DANIEL ROBERT VUJEVIC PROMISING NEW PROFESSIONAL AWARD

1. Objective

The ***Daniel Robert Vujevic Promising New Professional Award*** recognizes a member of the Alberta Branch of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors who, in the eyes of his/her colleagues, has actively demonstrated outstanding service to the Institute and/or the profession of environmental public health.

Mr. Daniel Robert Vujevic (Dan) embodied the intent of this award during his career as an Environmental Public Health Professional in southern Alberta. Dan was a member in good standing with the CIPHI Alberta Branch and demonstrated an innate competency and proficiency in the field of environmental public health. Dan was motivated to pursue opportunities to advance both his own technical expertise and the profession of environmental health through committee work and attendance at workshops, conferences and CIPHI Alberta Branch events. In 2010, the Alberta Branch lost a committed member and friend. It was the unanimous desire of both the Executive and the membership to name this award in Dan's memory so that the legacy of his professional approach would carry forward as an inspiration to those who are new to the field.

The award is given to a member of CIPHI Alberta Branch who has been in the field of environmental public health (EPH) in Alberta, the Northwest Territories or Nunavut for no more than two years from the date stated on the nominee's Certificate in Public Health Inspection (Canada).

2. Eligibility and Criteria

In order to be eligible for nomination, the following criteria must be satisfied:

- The nominee must be a member-in-good standing of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) and work in Alberta.
- The nomination must be made and seconded by individuals who are members-in-good standing of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (Alberta Branch) and have been in the EPH profession for more than five years.
- Accurate completion of the nomination form.
- A narrative of no more than 500 words outlining the accomplishments and contributions of the nominee must be completed and attached with the nomination form.
- A photocopy of the nominee's Certificate in Public Health Inspection (Canada) or other suitable documentation which indicates date of certification.

3. Application

Only one award recipient will be chosen by the Executive each calendar year.

The recipient's name may be posted on the CIPHI Alberta Branch Website and printed in the *Alberta Branch Newsletter* to inform the membership.

The Executive of the CIPHI Alberta Branch will review, assess, and modify this award as necessary to reflect the philosophy and best interests of the Association and its' membership.
